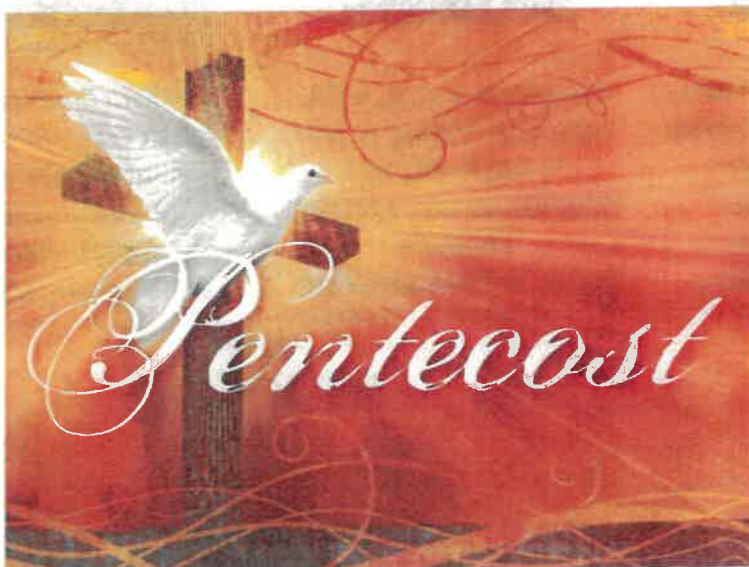
ASCENSION OF THE LORD - MAY 21ST, 2023
